## THE CONVERSATIONS OF TEAMS

A team is a set of on-going conversations regarding certain types of commitments. The following conversations for commitment must take place if a team is to be a team and succeed in the work it undertakes.

- Team members commit to coordinate action for the sake of a shared strategic mission.
- 2. Team members commit to owning the shared mission.
- 3. Team members commit to fulfill a particular role or domain of action in the team's division of labor.
- 4. All members commit to develop and carry on practices to anticipate future breakdowns and future opportunities for the team's mission.
- Team members commit to the team's unity of command and the policies or protocols that will be followed.
- 6. Members commit to evoke and produce trust.
- 7. Team members commit to a mood of success in the mission.
- 8. Team members commit to the team's standards for assessment.
- Team members commit to the future of the organization, to the team and to each other's careers.
