A tale of two states....



Cook and Collar Counties

Opioids continue to be in both Supply and Demand

Heroin Seizures and Lab Submissions Continue to Decline

Fentanyl and its Analogues Continue to Increase

Novel Opioids Continue to Enter the Area

Isotonitazene, Flualprazolam, Brophine, etc



Cook and Collar Counties.....

Stimulant Seizures and Submissions Continue to Increase
Methamphetamine, Cocaine and Crack Cocaine
Many of These Contain Fentanyl as Well



Remaining Jurisdictions

Methamphetamine and Stimulants are Major Drug Threat

Most Meth is being imported into the Country

Crack and Powder Cocaine Continue to be In Large Supply

Areas Report Opioids are Problematic, but Not Readily Available

Commonalities...

Major Shift To Synthetic Drugs

Nearly All “Prescription Pills” Submitted for Analysis Return as Fentanyl

Oxy M30s, Xanax Bars

Most Ecstasy, or MDMA Pills Submitted for Analysis Return as Methamphetamine

Very Few Exhibits are a Single Source Drug; Most contain Fentanyl or an Analogue

LSD is Making a Large Resurgence

Cannabis and THC Vape Cartridges Continue to be Interdicted Destined for Illinois
