List of Community Services

Guidance for Prime Agencies

The purpose of the “List of Community Services” documents is to provide Prime Agencies and Class Members with specific information about available resources/services and instructions for their use in efforts to engage and support Class Members in their transition and settlement into community-based settings. These resources, for example, should include Permanent Supportive Housing, support services and available financial resources.

Two levels of information are included here:

1. The “List of Community Services – For Use By Prime Agencies” is for Prime Agencies to use to educate themselves and their Outreach Workers about available community resources and how to access them. Equipping outreach workers with a detailed list of available services for Class Members after transition will support both the outreach worker and the Class Member’s education and understanding of such services community and likely support the Class Member’s decision to transition. Whenever feasible and appropriate, Prime Agencies should introduce Class Members to these community-based services in-person.
2. The “List of Community Services – For Williams and Colbert Class Members” is to be shared with Class Members during the outreach and engagement process. Prime Agencies are required by the Implementation Plan to share this document with every Class Member during the outreach encounter, and to document this activity on the Outreach Activity Outcome Form.
