**Allegation**

On April 16, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of abuse from Community Alternatives Illinois, Incorporated. It is alleged that XXXXX mentally abused XXXXX. Allegedly XXXXX told XXXXX that she would beat her ass, to which XXXXX replied, “Well come on then.”

**Synopsis**

On the afternoon of April 16, 2018, XXXXX, XXXXX and XXXXX came to the XXXXX office for a house meeting, where XXXXX, XXXXX, XXXXX and XXXXX were in XXXXX office. XXXXX complained that XXXXX and XXXXX made her do laundry for the house and they laughed at her, while she performed the task. XXXXX and XXXXX denied this and XXXXX stated at no time did XXXXX and XXXXX ever make XXXXX do laundry for the house and laugh at her. XXXXX became irate. XXXXX instructed XXXXX to get XXXXX and XXXXX to assist. Upon XXXXX returning to the office, she and XXXXX got into a heated argument. The situation quickly escalated and at that time XXXXX stood between the two of them, with her back to XXXXX. XXXXX threatened to beat up XXXXX and XXXXX responded, “Well come on then.” XXXXX lunged at XXXXX at XXXXX and attempted to hit her, but did not make contact. XXXXX lunged at XXXXX, with her fists balled at her sides, but did not make contact. XXXXX and XXXXX said it appeared as if XXXXX was trying to provoke XXXXX to hit her. XXXXX was able to redirect XXXXX to her office, to calm her down. XXXXX instructed XXXXX to clock out for the day.

**Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of mental abuse is substantiated against XXXXX. The allegation of mental abuse is unsubstantiated against XXXXX.
