### **Allegation**

On August 4, 2016, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Cornerstone Services, Incorporated. It is alleged that XXXXX went to the bathroom and left XXXXX unsupervised. During that time, XXXXX eloped and was found two blocks away from the CILA, by the Rockdale Police. XXXXX was missing for approximately five minutes.

### **Synopsis**

On the afternoon of August 3, 2016, it was documented that XXXXX eloped from the XXXXX CILA, while XXXXX was in the bathroom. A short time later, XXXXX was escorted home, by the Rockdale Police. After being at the CILA a few minutes, XXXXX ran from the CILA again. XXXXX immediately followed and called the Rockdale police for assistance. Officers talked to XXXXX and he walked home, with XXXXX. In the process of switching supervision so XXXXX could go over to the other side of the CILA, XXXXX eloped a third time. XXXXX was taken to Saint Joseph Hospital, for a psychiatric evaluation; however, it was determined the evaluation was not necessary and XXXXX was released. Upon returning home, XXXXX continued to be agitated and wandered in and out of the CILA, for an unspecified length of time. A police report was not filed per Rockdale Police Department.

### **Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.
