**Allegation**

On July 3, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Marcfirst. It was alleged that XXXXX required in-line-of-sight-of staff supervision when outside. He walked out on the CILA patio, without a staff member, fell, hitting his head causing a laceration to his forehead. Neglect was suspected.

**Synopsis**

XXXXX is a high-risk for falls according to his ISP, but the plan does not address preventing falls and he was not on any enhanced supervision at the time of this incident. On July 3, 2017, XXXXX walked out of the CILA and onto the patio unobserved, where he fell, causing a scalp laceration. He was successfully treated for his injury at the hospital. XXXXX had no guidelines to help them prevent XXXXX's fall. XXXXX stated he would have been responsible for making any recommendations based on the risk assessment, along with the XXXXX being involved before a plan is approved and put in place. During the meeting held on April 5, 2017, the agency recommended that PT/OT is deferred due to level of participation and did not feel the need to put any safety measures in place despite XXXXX's high risk for falls.

**Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect against Marcfirst is substantiated. The allegation of neglect against XXXXX and XXXXX is unsubstantiated.
