Allegation

On December 10, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Community Alternatives Illinois, Inc. It is alleged that XXXXX failed to provide adequate supervision for XX XXXXXXXXXXXX XXXXX and she eloped.

Synopsis

XX XXXXXX is to receive 1-1 supervision during waking hours and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on weekends. XXXXX was working with XXXXX and providing 1-1 supervision for XX XXXXXXXXXXXX leaving XXXXX to supervise XX XXXXXXX. XXXXX said XX XXXXXXX got up during the night and watched T.V. with her in the living room. She said XX XXXXXXX went back to her room around 8:30 a.m. to lay down and she remained in the living room watching T.V. with XXXXX and talking on her cell phone. XXXXX arrived around 9:50 a.m. to provide 1-1 supervision for XX XXXXXXX. She said the door was locked and she had to ring the doorbell, which it took XXXXX four to five minutes to answer and let her in. She said it appeared to her XXXXX had been sleeping. XXXXX said she was told XX XXXXXXX was in her room, but when she checked, she was not there. A search of the house and backyard was done and XX XXXXXXX could not be found and XXXXX directed XXXXX to call 911. XXXXX was informed when calling 911 that officer had located XX XXXXXXX. XXXXX said she located XX XXXXXXX XX blocks from the group home walking very slowly. She said from the time she located XX XXXXXXX until the group home called to report her missing was nearly one hour. XXXXX returned X XXXXXXX to the house and was getting information on her. She said XXXXX said she was sitting in the living room and that XX XXXXXXX went out the back door. XXXXX observed that from the living room she was able to see both the front and back door.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.
