Allegation

On May 3, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Community Alternatives Illinois, Inc. It is alleged that XX XXXX did not have a 1:1 staff when he eloped from the CILA.

Synopsis

On May 3, 2018, XX XXXX did not have a 1:1 staff scheduled or present and he eloped from the XXXXXXXX CILA. Per XXXXXX, the elopement occurred around 11:30am, whereas XXXXXX said he got a call from XXXXXX regarding the elopement around 11:00am. Approximately 1 hour after receiving the call, XXXXXX found XX XXXX walking on the side of the road approximately 3.9 miles away from the CILA. XX XXXX’s Behavior Support Plan (BSP) specified that XX XXXX required a 1:1 staff during waking hours and XXXXXX made the staff schedule, but only had a 1:1 staff scheduled during the hours of 12:00pm to 12:00am. XX XXXX was not injured when XXXXXX found him and he was taken back to the CILA where he attempted to attack XXXXXX before being arrested by the Peoria Police Department. Per records, XX XXXX is at risk with strangers, he is dependent for recognizing and avoiding common dangers such as traffic safety, and he has a history of elopement, XXXX XXXXXXX, XXX-XXXX, XXXXXXXXXXXX XXXXXX XXXXXXXX, XXXXXXX, XXX XXXXX XXXXXXXXXXXX.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXXX.

Recommendations

The Office of The Inspector General recommends the following:

1. The agency ensures a staff is specifically as 1:1 staff and it is clearly notated on schedules for anyone who is working.
2. The agency ensures that Behavior Support Plans, or any kind of service plan, use a specific start date in the form of day, month, and year, instead of just a month and year.
