Allegation

On September 19, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect regarding Community Alternatives Illinois, Inc. (CAIL). It is alleged that CAIL failed to maintain Individual XXXXXXXX supervision level when CAIL failed to pick her up from her job at XXXXXXXX in a timely manner and XXXXXXXX was subsequently left alone in the community on July 26, 2018.

Synopsis

On July 26, 2018, CAIL did not pick XXXXXXXX at 2:00 p.m. at the end of her work day at XXXXXXXXXXXXXXX. XXXXXXXX did not have any alone time in the community and she was left alone in the community for around 2 hours or more until XXXXXX picked her up. Prior to being picked up, XXXXXXXX approached a male stranger and used his phone to call for a ride before returning to the school area to wait for XXXXXX arrival. XXXXXX did arrive and he transported XXXXXXXX home sometime after 5:00 p.m. Fortunately, XXXXXXXX was not injured or harmed. XXXXXXXX said she was scared, nervous, and worried when she was alone. XXXXXXXXXXXXXXX spoke to XXXXXXXX a few days after the incident and XXXXXXXX told her that she was scared and worried. Per various documentation, XXXXXXXX is at risk of sexual exploitation and manipulation. XXXXXXXXXXXXXXX said XXXXXXXX is susceptible to unwanted sexual advances. If someone walks up to her and shows a genuine interest in her, XXXXXXXX is very gullible and will do whatever that person wants her to do. XXXXXXXX would probably go with anyone anywhere if the person coerced her enough and XXXXXXXX does not know directional awareness and is susceptible to getting lost on her own.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded. The allegation of neglect is substantiated against Community Alternatives Illinois, Inc.
