Allegation

On July 13, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) received a reported allegation of neglect from Progressive Housing, Incorporated (PHI). It is alleged XXXXX gave Individual XXXXXXXX medication intended for another individual during the morning medication pass on July 13, 2017. XXXXXXXXX was given medications for the treatment of diabetes, which XXXXXXXXX does not have. Because of the error, XXXXXXXXX was transported to the hospital, where his blood sugar was 54, he was given intravenous fluids with glucose, and he was then admitted to the hospital until his blood sugars returned to normal.

Synopsis

On the morning of July 13, 2017, XXXXX gave XXXXXXXXX medication intended for another individual. Because of receiving the wrong medication, he was admitted to the hospital with incidental ingestion of the wrong medications and was found to be hypoglycemic, with a blood sugar of 54 (normal range for a before-the-meal level is approximately 70-130; normal range for 1-2 hours after a meal is approximately 100-170). He was treated with intravenous glucose with fluids and given glucose orally. He was monitored overnight until his blood sugar returned to normal, and was discharged home the following day.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case, the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.
