Allegation

On January 21, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Neumann Family Services (NFS). It is alleged on or about December 31, 2016, XXXXX took individuals XXXXX XXXXX, XXXXX, XXXXX, XXXXX, XXXXX, and XXXXX, with him to the south side of Chicago to purchase marijuana. It is also alleged XXXXX took XXXXX, XXXXX and XXXXX on a walk to the alley at the CILA to smoke marijuana.

Synopsis

XXXXXX told XXXXX on December 31, 2016, XXXXX drove them in the van to the south side of Chicago for personal reasons unrelated to his job. He stopped at a gas station and a house and at each location XXXXX purchased something green in a plastic wrapper he believed to be marijuana. During the trip, he left them unattended in the van, with the keys in the ignition. Tracking logs sheet show on December 31, 2016, the van traveled from the CILA to 35th and Damen on the south side. Witnesses stated XXXXX smoked swisher cigars on the job. In January 2017, he took several individuals for a walk in the alley and smoked a swisher cigar. XXXXX stated it contained marijuana. XXXXX stated when XXXXX, returned from the walk, he smelled of marijuana, his eyes were red and he had the munchies. XXXXX was terminated in accordance with NFS's drug policy for possession of an illegal drug while on job.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case, the following was concluded. The allegation of neglect against XXXXX is substantiated.

Recommendations

The Office of The Inspector General recommends that the agency address the failure to file a police report regarding XXXXX illegal possession of marijuana while on duty.
