### **Allegation**

On July 10, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Clearbrook. It was alleged that on July 10, 2017, XXXXX left individuals XXXXX and XXXXX unsupervised at the CILA for an undetermined length of time.

### **Synopsis**

On July 10, 2017, XXXXX transported XXXXX, XXXXX, XXXXX and XXXXX from the day training program to the CILA. XXXXX left her wallet containing her driver's license inside an Uber vehicle. She left the home to retrieve the wallet and took XXXXX with her. She left the other individuals at the home. XXXXX was allowed unlimited alone time at the home. XXXXX was allowed one-hour home alone time. However, XXXXX is unable to be left in the home alone. XXXXX used the agency's van to pick up the wallet from the Uber driver. She also drove to a pharmacy to pick up the residents' medications while out of the home. It was never determined how long XXXXX was away from the home. XXXXX admitted that she left the home knowing that XXXXX required supervision while in the home. In addition, she failed to notify supervisory staff of her need to leave the home.

### **Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded. The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.
