Allegation

On September 30, 2017, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Orchard Village. It was alleged that XXXXX gave XXXXX chicken nuggets for dinner, that caused her stomach pains and sent her to the hospital.

Synopsis

XXXXX is on a gluten free diet and is restricted from eating chicken nuggets which contain gluten. XXXXX admitted to purchasing chicken nuggets for her, from Burger King, that contained glutes. XXXXX was aware of her dietary restrictions. XXXXX became ill, after eating the chicken nuggets. She was taken to the emergency room and was diagnosed with non-intractable vomiting with nausea, and dehydration.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect against XXXXX is substantiated.

Recommendations

The Office of The Inspector General recommends the following:

- That XXXXX be tested to find out if her diagnosis of Alzheimer is affecting her ability to make good judgement calls, when selecting and eating foods, that may cause her stomach pain, given her dietary restrictions.
- That her gluten free diet be evaluated, to determine if it is addressing her diagnosed dietary deficiencies.
