Allegation

On February 3, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Oak-Leyden Developmental Services, Inc. It is alleged that XXXXX accidentally gave XXXXX XXXXX' medication at 7:00 a.m. on February 3, 2018.

Synopsis

On February 3, 2018, during the morning medication passing, XXXXX prepared XXXXX' medication and passed it to him in a cup. XXXXX walked into the kitchen and placed the cup containing his medication on the counter and went into the bathroom. XXXXX admitted he did not observe XXXXX taking his medication as he was exhibiting a behavior. XXXXX took the cup off the counter containing XXXXX' medication and ingested it. XXXXX took lamotrigine 25 mg (Seizure Disorder), Propranolol 60 mg (high blood pressure, chest pain, uneven heartbeat, migraine headaches) quetiapine 300mg (Schizoaffactive Disorder), clonazepam 1mg (Seizure Disorder), carbamazepine ER 300 mg (Seizure Disorder), and niacin 250 mg (Supplement). XXXXX became dizzy, his blood pressure dropped, and he was transported to West Suburban Hospital by ambulance.

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded. The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.

Recommendations

The Office of the Inspector General recommends the following:

- Oak-Leyden Developmental Services, Inc. address XXXXX failure to report the allegation of neglect in a timely manner which is a violation of 20 ILCS 1305/1-17 (a). The willful failure to comply with OIG's reporting requirements is a Class A misdemeanor.
- Ensure that XXXXX is provided with medication retraining.
