**Allegation**

On April 6, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Fox Developmental Center. It is alleged that XXXXX left XX XXXXXXXX XXXX unattended, who was under 1-1 supervision, arms-length, on the bath Trolley while he walked away approximately fifteen (15) feet to the door to yell for assistance.

**Synopsis**

XXXXX took XX XXXXX to the bathroom to bathe her, where he used the Hoyer lift to transfer her to the trolley table. While bathing XX XXXXX, he observed redness around her stoma site and looked to see if there was an ointment he could apply to the area. He rang the doorbell for assistance to make sure the ointment was the correct one to use and when no one responded after five minutes, he rang the bell again. When no one still responded, XXXXX walked to the door approximately 15 feet away from XX XXXXX, he opened the door and asked XXXXX for assistance. He then he realized he had left XX XXXXX unattended on the trolley and immediately went back over by her. XXXXX said he knows that it was against Fox DC policy by walking away from XX XXXXX. Fox Developmental Center policy requires individuals to have ongoing direct staff supervision while bathing unless specifically noted in their Individual Support Plan and under no circumstances is an individual to be using a bathing device without a staff person in the bathroom to provide rapid intervention should an emergency occur. According to XX XXXXX's ISP, she is required to receive 1-1 supervision, arms reach while bathing and there is nothing in her ISP that states otherwise.

**Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX.
