Allegation

On May 17, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Fox Developmental Center. It is alleged that XXXXX fed individual XXXXX, who is on a pureed diet, solid foods. Neglect was suspected.

Synopsis

XXXXXX is on a pureed diet, with the only exception being spaghetti and ravioli cut into half inch pieces with sauce. All other foods must be pureed. On May 17, 2018, XXXXX took XXXXX to a restaurant and fed him scrambled eggs and cottage cheese. She had his diet order with her at the restaurant and admitted to making the decision to deviate from the order, because she felt that scrambled eggs and cottage cheese are somewhat the same consistency to the spaghetti and ravioli cut into half inch pieces. According to XXXXX's Meal Protocol, cottage cheese and eggs are listed as foods that need to be pureed because these placed XXXXX at substantial risk of aspiration (food particles entering the air way and lungs).

Findings

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX. The allegation of neglect against Mental Health Technician XXXXX is unsubstantiated.
