### **Allegation**

On April 5, 2018, the Office of the Inspector General received a reported allegation of neglect from Elisabeth Ludeman Developmental Center (LDC). It is alleged that XXXXX and XXXXX neglected the care of individual XXXXX. On April 5, 2018, while XXXXX was assigned to one to one supervision for XXXXX, XXXXX rubbed and reopened a previous wound, which began to bleed profusely. Reportedly, XXXXX and XXXXX did not apply pressure to wound and XXXXX was covered in blood. XXXXX was transported to Saint James Hospital.

### **Synopsis**

On April 5, 2018, XXXXX was assigned to provide 1:1 supervision to XXXXX. When XXXXX arrived at House XXXXX, at approximately 2:40am, she noticed XXXXX was bleeding non-stop, from the side of his face. She immediately called the operator, to page the Registered Nurse (RN). This was corroborated by XXXXX. XXXXX stated that she arrived at 3:00am, and noticed XXXXX was bleeding profusely from the left side of his forehead and she applied direct pressure and dressed the wound. XXXXX reported that due to volume of blood, the Medical Doctor on Call (MOD) was notified and XXXXX was transported to the hospital. XXXXX and XXXXX both stated that XXXXX just sat in front of XXXXX and XXXXX said he was not trained to deal with this type of situation. However, the LDC training records documented that XXXXX was trained in First Aid. XXXXX admitted that he failed to contact the RN, as required per policy.

### **Findings**

Based on the facts in this case the following was concluded: The allegation of neglect is substantiated against XXXXX. The allegation of neglect is unsubstantiated against XXXXX.
